



### **Position - Environmental Scientist/Engineer**

The successful applicant will be effective at both independent and collaborative work and adept at proactive problem solving; initiating and completing new projects; effective time management of multiple projects; and attention to detail.

**Required:** (1) A Bachelor's Degree in a Natural Science or Engineering. (2) Demonstrated excellence in clear and accurate technical writing and communications for diverse audiences.
