PROJECT UPDATE: Green Seal Laundry Care Product Scoping Period - Extended Until December 23

Thank you for your continued interest in Green Seal's development of an environmental standard for Laundry Care Products. To allow for more time for receiving comments and allowing stakeholders to get involved in the process during the scope of the project, Green Seal is extending the scoping period to **Tuesday, December 23, 2008**. The scoping period is a key step to involve all stakeholders in the development of this standard. In particular, Green Seal requests comments regarding the inclusion of both institutional and consumer laundry care products within the same standard. Comments will be submitted through an online forum system until December 23, 2008.
