

GS-11 Project Update
March 13, 2008

Green Seal is revising the GS-11 Paints Standard and GC-03 Anti-Corrosive Paints Standard and intends to merge the standards into one standard. The Environmental Standard for Paints and Coatings (GS-11) is currently undergoing final review. The 2nd Draft of the Final Revised Standard and the Balloting Comments document are available on the GS-11 standard development website.

Depending on the final review process, Green Seal anticipates issuing the GS-11 final revised standard in the next few months. Once the final revised standard is issued, the certification process will re-open. Any preliminary applications that were received for Green Seal certification under GS-11 or GC-3 during the revision process will be sent the final revised standard. Applicants are encouraged to review the revised standard and resume the application process by submitting a new Preliminary Application online. Certified product manufacturers or any products whose review is in process (have not been awarded certification) will be contacted when the final revised standard is issued.
