Editorial Revision Summary

GS-53 Standard for Specialty Cleaning Products for Industrial and Institutional Use

During April 2014, Green Seal issued Edition 2.2 of our Specialty Cleaning Product Standards – GS-52 and GS-53. Details of this revision can be reviewed on [Green Seal's website](#).



Edition 2.2 of GS-53 contained an editorial error in *Section 3.5 Carcinogens and Reproductive Toxins*. The sentence highlighted below should have been deleted, but was accidentally left in the text in the final edition.

3.5 *Carcinogens and Reproductive Toxins. The *undiluted product* shall not contain any *components* that are *carcinogens* or *reproductive toxins*. **The product shall not contain any *components* known to produce or release *carcinogens*.** The *undiluted product* shall not contain any components at 0.01% or more that, according to published uses, are typically added for the purpose of releasing *carcinogens* in a raw material or the final product.

All public versions of the proposal, including the [Proposed Revisions](#) document (published on January 3, 2014), provided the correct proposed text with the highlighted sentence struck out.

Resolution:

We are now re-issuing a corrected edition of GS-53 Edition 2.3, Section 3.5 now correctly reads as follows:

3.5 *Carcinogens and Reproductive Toxins. The *undiluted product* shall not contain any *components* that are *carcinogens* or *reproductive toxins*. The *undiluted product* shall not contain any components at 0.01% or more that, according to published uses, are typically added for the purpose of releasing *carcinogens* in a raw material or the final product.

This revision is editorial, and the text above is identical to the proposed version. Therefore, we are not releasing this revision for Public Comment.
